ATTENTION

MERCHANDISE ON SIDEWALK PROHIBITED

It is a violation of Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Section 56.11 to display upon or obstruct the public sidewalk or parkway with any type of merchandise or any article of personal property.

ADVERTISING SIGNS ON SIDEWALK PROHIBITED

LAMC Section 56.08 (E) prohibits the display of any type of advertising sign or obstruction on the public sidewalk or parkway. Any violations of LAMC Section 56.08 (E) may result on the removal of the sign by City forces and fees levied.

STORES AND BUSINESSES MUST HAVE A COMMERCIAL RUBBISH SERVICE

LAMC Section 66.17.1 requires any manager or person in charge of or in control of, any store or business to provide written proof of rubbish service upon request of any Municipal Inspector. Commercial rubbish service must be maintained.

SIDEWALK – CLEANING OF

LAMC Section 41.46 requires any person not fail, refuse or neglect to keep the sidewalk in front their business in a clean and wholesome condition.

STREET – PACKING – UNPACKING PROHIBITED

LAMC Section 56.12 prohibits the packing or unpacking of merchandise on any street, sidewalk or parkway.

Please be advised that any violations of the Los Angeles Municipal Code sections may result in a Citation (Notice to Appear in Municipal Court) issued to the store or business manager or person in charge. Judges may impose up to \$1000 and/or six months in jail.
